



ADDRESSING PLAYER ISSUES

Occasionally, issues arise that must be addressed involving player actions outside the Code of Conduct. These issues may include but not be limited to; playing time, tardiness, or player demeanor. In order to keep these issues relatively private for all parties involved, we ask that you follow these guidelines when handling these types of issues.

1. Do NOT address these issues before, during or immediately after an event (practice, game, other)
2. The player should address the situation first with the coach in a one on one scenario at a mutually appropriate time.
3. If no resolution is reached, the player and her parent(s) may meet with the coach to discuss the situation at a mutually appropriate time.
4. If again, no resolution is reached, the player, parent(s) and coach will meet to discuss the situation at a mutually appropriate time.
5. If the issue is directly related to a specific event, a mandatory 48 hour cooling off period is required prior to any proposed meeting.

Failure to work within these guidelines will be considered a breach of the Code of Conduct Agreement and may result in applicable corrective action.
